Integrated Teacher Training Scheme (ITTS)

Starting in the second half of 2012. This initiative promoted by The Ringing Foundation aims to train new bellringing instructors and give them up-to-date teaching skills, with two modules: Teaching Bell Handling, and Teaching Elementary Change Ringing. There is a one day course for each module, mentor support for new teachers, teacher training log-book, on-line learning using the internet and accreditation at the end of module two for both teachers and mentors. Entry level for Module Two is an ability to ring Plain Bob Minor to quarter peal standard.
