Chair's Message

Dear Friends

One of my missions over the past year as UERSA Chair has been to seek closer links with the University. Three of us from the UERSA Executive Committee were invited recently to a focus group meeting organised by the University, but led by an independent facilitator, to develop a better understanding of how it engages with alumni and former staff. What became clear from the discussion was that communication with both groups could be enhanced – indeed, I think it was accepted that the University maintains no formal communication at all with its former employees! There was some emphasis at the meeting on the mechanics of fundraising (especially around the University's current *Making the exceptional happen* campaign), but we suggested that the assistance of UERSA members might be better sought in terms of time and experience rather than just cash. It will be interesting to see the headlines emerging from the facilitator's report.

However, as an organisation we have been making some welcome progress in working more closely with the University, in particular in collaborating over the organisation of campus visits for UERSA. Following the success of the Living Systems Institute visit earlier in the year, and despite some threatening weather, 26 members recently joined a couple of very enjoyable afternoon tours arranged with the University of sculptures on the Streatham Estate, some outside, some inside. You can see photos on the UERSA website. The tours were led by Naome Glanville, the University's Arts and Culture Co-ordinator, who was very happy to receive information on the spot about the history of some of the longer-standing exhibits which had been lost somewhat in the mists of time, an example of where UERSA memories can be helpful! I'm hopeful that you can look forward to other campus events over the coming year.

Other recent events for the general membership were a river trip on the Dart and the traditional summer party. The former, organised so efficiently by Chris Austin, saw good weather, splendid scenery and was much appreciated by all those who participated. Although attendance at the summer party, again held at Exeter Cricket Club's new pavilion, was lower than last year, there was a unanimous view that the catering was much improved. Conversation was both cheery and noisy, as you might expect when former colleagues get together. One innovation was a retiring collection, in this instance for Hospiscare, which raised £103.20. Our next general social events will be the annual quiz, to be held on 18 October (details attached), and the Christmas lunch, this year scheduled for 14 December at the usual venue of the Devon Hotel (details to be circulated in due course).

Finally, can I urge you to attend the AGM on Thursday 28 September (for which papers are attached)? As well as a chance for a little early-evening socialising, it's the principal opportunity for you to have your say on UERSA and its activities; or even put your name forward for membership of the Executive Committee! I look forward to seeing a good crowd of you there.

UNIVERSITY NEWS

Gold Standard in TEF Award

The University has been awarded the Teaching Excellence Framework gold rating. Rankings are made based on factors including graduate employability, teaching and education, and student satisfactions.

Higher Education and Brexit

Vice-Chancellor Sir Steve Smith, Chair of the UUK Policy Group negotiating the shape of relationships with European academic staff after the UK leaves the EU, is reported to have expressed serious concern about the impact of Brexit on our HE institutions and currently cannot see a clear picture of what will emerge. 17% of academic staff in UK universities are from other EU countries and there are more than 125,000 EU students at UK universities. The UK is also a major participant in EU research programmes.

Building Award

The University's Living Systems Institute, visited by some of our members earlier this year, has received awards for Building of the Year and Education Project of the Year, at the 2017 Michelmores Property Awards.

Dementia Research Grant

The Alzheimer's Society has awarded £2m to the University's Centre of Excellence in Dementia Care Research, to improve the quality of life for people with dementia, and care in advanced dementia. The funding will be used for a national collaboration led by Professor Linda Clare at Exeter.

Northcott Theatre

Dame Judi Dench has agreed to be the Theatre's patron for its 50th anniversary year, which will begin with a gala on Sunday 12 November. Lady Studholme, Chair of the Theatre, has expressed pleasure and pride about Dame Judi's involvement.

Treasurer's Report for 2016/17

The UERSA account is held within the general University financial system, and is audited as part of this system at the close of each financial year on 31st July. I am extremely grateful to Mrs Lynda Swallow of Finance Services for being such a helpful and efficient point of contact with that system.

The position at audit for the immediate past and three preceding years is given below. "Events" are those that have been advertised in newsletters for all members, while "Activities" are those held within special interest groups. It was agreed by the Executive Committee some years ago that the latter should aim to break even but the former could be supported from general funds; events that benefited in this way in 2016/17 were the refreshments after the AGM, the Christmas lunch, and the summer Garden Party. "Administration Costs" cover printing, photocopying, postal charges and general running expenses, while "Disbursements" comprise donations approved by the Committee. These were to Wonford Methodist Church, who had supplied crockery for use at previous Garden Parties, and to Exeter Cricket Club who had made available the pavilion for the Garden Party as well as parking space throughout the year for members attending events. A donation for the summer 2017 garden party will appear in the 2017/18 accounts

AMENDMENTS TO CONSTITUTION

The UERSA Executive Committee recommends approval of the following amendments to UERSA's constitution. The intentions are to:

To include the Website Editor as a named member of the Executive Committee (which will increase the size of the Committee by one).

To regularise the election of members to the Committee, including clarifying terms of office.

Replace under section 6 (Executive Committee):

(a) The Business of the Association will be conducted by the Executive Committee consisting of the Chair, the Secretary, the Treasurer, the Membership Secretary, the Social Secretary, the Editor of the Newsletter, four General Members, and the President ex-officio.

(b) The above officers will be elected by the Annual General Meeting and will serve for a three-year term which may be extended for a further term of three years. The General Members will be elected annually for one year, renewable for up to four years.

with:

(a) The business of the Association will be conducted by an Executive Committee comprising the Chair, the Secretary, the Treasurer, the Membership Secretary, the Social Co-ordinator, the Newsletter Editor, the Website Editor, the President (ex-officio) and four general members.

(b) The members of the Committee will be elected by the Annual General Meeting. Save for the President, they will serve for a three-year term at a time and be eligible for re-election on completion of a term. Members may resign from the Committee at any time on notification to the Secretary.
